- Community affiliations with existing efforts to address Fatherhood and/or supporting Fathers
- Strong written, verbal, interpersonal, organizational, and problem-solving skills
- Fluent in use of the internet and Windows-based computer systems
- Flexible hours, willing to work some evenings and weekends
